"FARMAN"

Nawab Osman Ali Khan, the seventh Nizam of Hyderabad, issued a farman (Royal charter) on April 17th 1918 which detailed the 'Mission' and 'Objectives' of the University to be that: "the ancient and modern, the oriental and occidental arts and sciences are synthesized in such a manner that the defects of the present system of education are rectified. ...the ancient as well as modern methods of physical, intellectual and spiritual education are to be fully utilized along with an effort for the propagation of knowledge, the moral improvement of the students is regulated on the one hand, and research work of a high order in all branches of knowledge is conducted on the other."
